School Responsibilities

The Arenac Eastern School District will:

1. Provide high quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the State's student academic achievement standards as follows:

2. Hold Parent-teacher conferences (at least annually in elementary schools) during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement.
 - a. Parent-teacher conferences will be held on September 25, 2009, February 11, 2010 (evening) and February 15, 2010 (afternoon). Actual times will be on the school's website and informational sign.
3. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress.
 - a. Parents will receive hard copy reports of their student's progress at the conclusion of every nine-week marking period.
 - b. Parents may also use the district's "Edline" to check, daily, on a student's progress via internet. (student codes available upon request.)
4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff.
 - a. Faculty and Staff members will generally be available after school for approximately 30 minutes.
 - b. Faculty and Staff members will be available for a personal conference as per request and appointment.
 - c. The school maintains a telephone for each teacher and directory is available.
5. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities.
 - a. Parents are encouraged to volunteer for special activities and field trips.
 - b. Parents are encouraged to visit classrooms and observe or participate as per request/appointment.
